Role and responsibilities as a volunteer

Main Duties

- To organize and prepare for activities, where appropriate.
- To assist and where appropriate to participate alongside the community and to carry out tasks in a way that meets the aims and values of Dillsboro Main Street.
- To attend and take part in planning meetings when available.
- To work within the policies, guidelines, and legal requirements of Dillsboro Main Street.

Availability

- Quarterly meetings will be held to discuss the needs of the group. Typically, this will involve the Dillsboro Main Street Promotions committee. All volunteers are encouraged to attend.
- Volunteers are asked to give their time in 2 hours increments, when available for Dillsboro Main Street Community Events or planning. The Community Events volunteer opportunities may be the day of the actual event, prior to the event for setup, or planning/prepping for the event.
 Volunteer opportunities will be published on dillsboromainstreet.com or discussed at the quarterly Volunteer Meeting. Otherwise, please contact Nicole Sparkman at 937-559-8640 to discuss these events.
- The volunteers should notify Dillsboro Main Street in advance if they are unable to attend the opportunities for which they signed up.
- Volunteer as much or as little as desired. All time given is appreciated.
- Volunteer hours will be tracked for those who will need proof as extracurricular activities.

- Volunteers shall obey all applicable local, state, and federal laws, while acting on behalf of the Dillsboro Main Street, including all laws and regulations.
- Volunteers shall seek assistance if they have questions about any volunteer guidelines, including the Code of Conduct.
- Volunteers shall report violations or suspected violations of the Code of Conduct.
